Dear Colleagues,

It is a great pleasure for me to invite you to the 24th Annual Meeting and Refresher Course of the European Society of Head and Neck Radiology in Brugge.

During this second ESHNR meeting held in Brugge, there will be general sessions covering imaging of most of the ENT-regions and the emphasis will be on new techniques and possibilities. Clinical correlation will be stressed during a special *“temporal bone session”* where surgeon-radiologist duos will discuss the most important and frequent problems. Another special session *“How does it work”* will provide practical information about the new CT and MR techniques, practical information anyone of us can use to produce better images. A special session on *“Cone Beam CT”* will be organized during a common session with the 4th International Congress on 3D diagnosis and virtual planning of cranio-maxillo-facial deformity. Technique, indications and clinical use of CBCT will pass the revue. For those participants who plan to buy a CBCT it will be a golden opportunity to see and compare the different systems, which will be on display. Finally Prof. Tony Mancuso, one of the founders of CT and MR based Head and Neck imaging, will be honored for the important impact he had on the development of Head and Neck imaging in Western Europe during the session *“The Mancuso generation”*. Some of his students and himself will show how some of the early dreams in Head and Neck radiology over the years became or almost became reality.

Since 2000 Bruges became a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The Congress venue *“Congress Centre Old Sint-Jan”* is situated in the center of this medieval city and is located in the buildings of the former Sint-Jan Hospital, from which the oldest buildings are 860-year-old. A social programme with a welcome reception at the St. Sebastian Guild (where Charles II of England formed his army) and a Gala dinner at the Belfry will allow the participants and accompanying guests to discover more of our fascinating city.
