Professional Summary:

As a Diagnostic Neuroradiologist at the University Hospital Bern, FW has a wealth of clinical expertise coupled with a distinct passion for pioneering advancements in neuroimaging. Actively engaged in clinically applied interdisciplinary research, she is focused on both practical applications and theoretical advancements. FW takes pride in leading and organizing research efforts that bridge the gap between clinical practice and academic exploration. Her commitment extends beyond clinical practice to encompass not only interdisciplinary research, but also organizational leadership in research initiatives, impactful teaching at the university level, and a significant body of published works.

Focus of her clinical and scientific research – three main topics:

1. Otolaryngological (ENT) imaging throughout the pre-, intra-, and postoperative phases.
2. Neuroradiological "critical care" diagnostics with an emphasis on neuro-intensive care medicine.
3. Neuroimmunological and neurodegenerative diseases (in particular, multiple sclerosis) with a special focus on risk stratification and outcome prediction for affected patients, as well as disease monitoring with imaging techniques.

Her vision focuses on multidisciplinary collaborations and excellence in clinical performance to position neuroradiology as an essential medical discipline.
